What is the aim of the Barkisland School Financial Support Fund?

The aim of the Barkisland School Financial Support Fund is to help children and their families who have difficulties paying for:

- Curriculum trips, visits, year group residentials and other activities
- School meals
- Uniform, shoes or sports kit
- Other materials or equipment to assist in academic studies
- Childcare costs
- Other necessary expenses

We recognise that families have different needs at different times. All families are able to apply for support from this Financial Support Fund. Payments from the Fund are discretionary. Payments are a grant, not a loan, and do not need to be repaid.

All applications for help from the Barkisland School Financial Support Fund are treated in the strictest confidence.

Who is eligible? – Any family with children registered at Barkisland CofE (VA) Primary School or Little Lambs Nursery Provision.

Rather than using income as the deciding factor, we will consider the following criteria:

- Families informing the school that they are in a state of immediate crisis and are not currently entitled to free school meals (FSM).
- Families who may have been impacted by job loss, loss of self-employed income or those already impacted by in-work poverty.
- Families where childcare issues have resulted in job loss or reduction of hours, forcing a crisis.
- Families waiting for benefits claims to be assessed resulting in short term financial difficulties, if emergency grants are pending or have already been used up.
- Families where we have identified that a young person is acting as a carer, thus creating additional vulnerabilities and pressures.
- Families impacted by potential homelessness.
- Any other factor that renders a family in need of financial assistance.

How do I apply?

All requests will be considered on an individual basis and School and family will work together to agree a level of support. Agreements will be reviewed every half term.
