Instructions for anyone wanting to enter the Royal Academy of Arts Young Artists' Summer Show 2024

"...we believe in nurturing and celebrating the next generation of artists."

Deadline 5pm Wednesday 27th March 2024



Entry is free and open to young artists aged 4-19 years. All children 12 years old or under will need a parent/guardian to enter on their behalf. 13 and overs can submit themselves. Only 1 entry per person. There are prizes awarded and the public can vote for prize winners too.

Judging: May 2024 - Online exhibition open: 16th July 2024 - Display at the Royal Academy of Arts, London: 16th July – 11th August 2024

You'll need to register an account as a parent/guardian. The school is registered so when you have an account, you can log in and submit your child's work and select Barkisland CE (VA) Primary School from the list.

details. You will then be asked to upload an image of the artwork.

### What kind of artworks do you accept?

We've written gome guidance on the kinds of artwork the judges are looking for when they review submissions. The artwork can be made using any material; it can be a painting, sculpture, photograph, installation, video, drawing, or a combination. There is no theme so artworks can be of any subject and we don't mind when you made the artwork as long as you are between 4-19 years old when you submit it.
