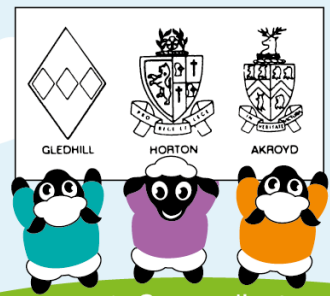

Dear Parents and Carers

Reception Summer Term Trip to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Doncaster – Wednesday 22nd May 2024

To enhance our topic of 'At the Zoo', we would like to take the children to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park on Wednesday 22nd May 2024. We will need the children to be in school at normal time and we will set off at 9.15am. The children will be travelling by coach. They will need to wear their school uniform and wear sensible footwear. We intend to return to school by 3.30pm depending on traffic.



We will contact school and you will be informed if we are going to be late.

Any children requiring travel sickness pills need to be given them before coming to school and a further dose should be handed to the Class Teacher, along with written instructions for the return journey.

All children will require a packed lunch for the day. **Those children who currently have school dinners will be provided with a packed lunch from school on the morning of the trip.** School prepared packed lunches will include: a sandwich (children will choose from a choice of fillings in class), raisins, a babybel and a yoghurt and a fairy cake along with a carton of fruit juice or bottled water. Children who bring packed lunches from home will be expected to do so on the trip day. Please note: we are a nut free school therefore please do not send any produce that contains, or may contain nuts. **If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch please let us know prior to the trip.** All packed lunch items need to be entirely disposable but no glass bottles please.

The cost of the trip will be £27.00 per child, which is available to pay in 2 instalments, this includes entry to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park and the return coach trip. The BSA has very kindly agreed to pay half of the cost of the coach. If your child would like to go but you are unable to meet the cost of their trip, please do get in touch with us, in confidence. Payment will be made via the School Spider online system – you will receive notification once this is available. Please do this by Friday 17th May at the latest.

Please complete the school spider consent form to give your consent for your child to go on the trip, by Friday 17th May at the latest.

Please note, that if you are in receipt of pupil premium funding, the cost of the trip will be paid for by school via this funding. However, please make sure that you still complete the consent form by Friday 17th May.
