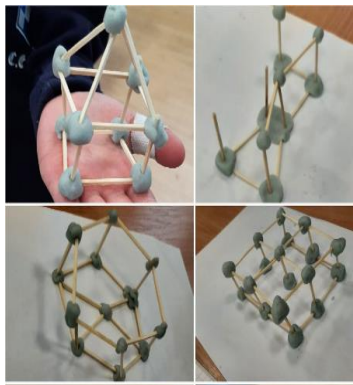
At Barkisland Art & DT are taught progressively throughout the year, where children develop key knowledge, skills and understanding throughout each year group.
