Superkind - Social Impact Schools Award

I am delighted to let you know that we are taking part in the **Superkind** programme this year. Their Social Impact Schools Award will formally recognise and celebrate the amazing social actions that our school and your children take over the school year.

Social action is a key part of personal and character development, encouraging children to think about others and to make a positive to contribution to society. We know that by getting involved in things like volunteering, campaigning and fundraising, children are growing themselves while also benefiting the world around them.

Individual recognition - children will earn bronze, silver then gold digital badges each time they complete an act with social impact. There are 12 categories of social action so 36 badges to earn. Outstanding contributions will be celebrated in collective worship.
