



Nursery Settling in Survey 2024-2025

Why did you choose Barkisland Little Lambs Nursery as a choice for your child? 9 responses




The communication we received from the school once a place had been confirmed gave us enough information about joining Nursery.



















Summary of Responses:

The overall sentiment expressed in the parent responses is very positive. Parents are highly satisfied with the school, particularly the welcoming and caring environment, the strong relationships between staff and pupils, and the opportunities provided for pupils to engage in a variety of school activities. Parents feel their children have settled in quickly and are thriving at the school. While there are a few areas for improvement suggested, the responses indicate a high level of satisfaction and a strong recommendation for the school.

Common Strengths Identified:

- Pupils have settled in very well, with a quick and smooth transition, especially for those who previously attended different nurseries
- The classroom environment is described as a "lovely place to learn", with engaging displays, floor books, and opportunities to see pupils' work
- The staff are praised for quickly building strong, caring relationships with the pupils and getting to know them well.
- Pupils are provided with opportunities to experience different aspects of school life, such as worship sessions and access to outdoor facilities
- The school is welcoming, caring, and staff are genuinely invested in pupils' development
- Communication between the school and parents is excellent, with a good level of familiarity and responsiveness.
- Smooth transition and settling-in process for new pupils



Areas for Development:

- More regular updates on what pupils have been learning and working on, beyond the information provided through the school's social media and pick-up boards
- Providing more detailed information through the school's communication app, as some parents feel the information shared is not always very informative
- Sharing more photos of pupils' experiences and activities, where possible, to help parents stay informed about their child's school life
