## <u>Extra-Curricular Clubs – Spring 2 2025</u> Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025

I am delighted to let you know of the extra-curricular clubs we have planned for children in Reception-Y6 to take part in, if they wish, for Spring Term 2 2025. These clubs will run for 5 weeks from week commencing 24<sup>th</sup> February to week ending Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025 (except for UKS2 girls football which will run for 4 weeks – no session on Mon 3<sup>rd</sup> March). UKS2 Boys and Girls Football clubs will alternate each half-term between Jess on a lunchtime and Bryn after school. Netball club is currently only open to pupils within Year 5 & 6 as the upcoming RVHS Netball competition only allows children from these year groups to take part. Same with KS2 Tag Rugby, this is to prepare for a Y3/Y4 and Y5/Y6 tournament, so Bryn will adapt this Tag Rugby session accordingly.

- **Dodgeball/Nerf club** will be available for **KS1 children** this half-term and will be run by Bryn (Project Sports) in the Sutton Hall with the activities alternating each week. These activities will focus on co-ordination, agility and teamwork.
- Tea Time Church returns on Wednesdays Y3 Classroom. Available to everyone from Reception to Y6.
- **KS1 Get Moving** Children can do this in their school uniform. Active sessions including Just Dance, Go Noodle and other aerobic activities to get children moving.
- **KS2 Tag Rugby** we are reintroducing Tag Rugby due to preparing for the tournament. This is a minimal contact version of Rugby. Children will be given the chance to learn about the different techniques and skills, working on strategy and teamwork. All safety equipment is included.

To make the wide variety of clubs, sustainable and affordable for all, there is a small charge of £2 per child per session for each club. This goes towards covering the costs of employing external coaches and any equipment required. This excludes KS2 Drama and Theatre club which is £3 per session.

For those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, school will continue to fund the cost of extra-curricular clubs.

- <u>Netball & Dodgeball/Nerf clubs</u> as both clubs are being held in the Sutton Hall, children can wear their indoor PE kit.
